

Terms and conditions of use of Website

1. Introduction

- 1.1. These terms and conditions shall govern your use of our website.
- 1.2. By using our website, you accept these terms and conditions in full; accordingly, if you disagree with these terms and conditions or any part of these terms and conditions, you must not use our website.
- 1.3. If you register with our website or make a purchase on our website, we will ask you to expressly agree to these terms and conditions.
- 1.4. You must be at least 18 years of age to use our website; by using our website or agreeing to these terms and conditions, you warrant and represent to us that you are at least 18 years of age.
- 1.5. Our website uses cookies; by using our website or agreeing to these terms and conditions, you consent to our use of cookies in accordance with the terms of our privacy and cookies policy.

- 6.1. To be eligible for an account on our website under this Section 6, you must have a verifiable resident address in the United Kingdom.
